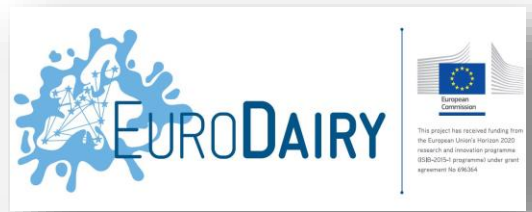


# Biodiversity workshop in Rhône-Alpes (France)
